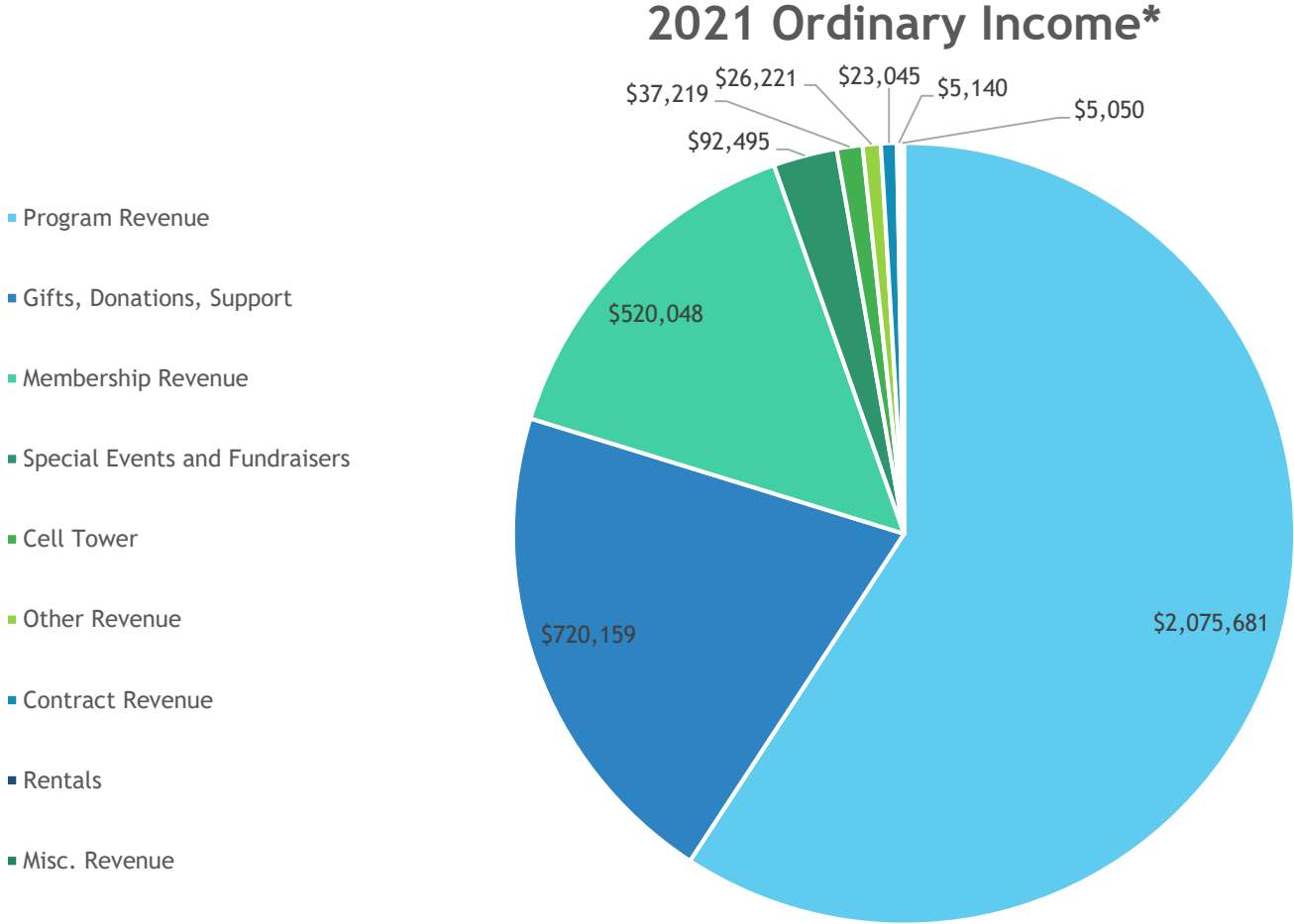

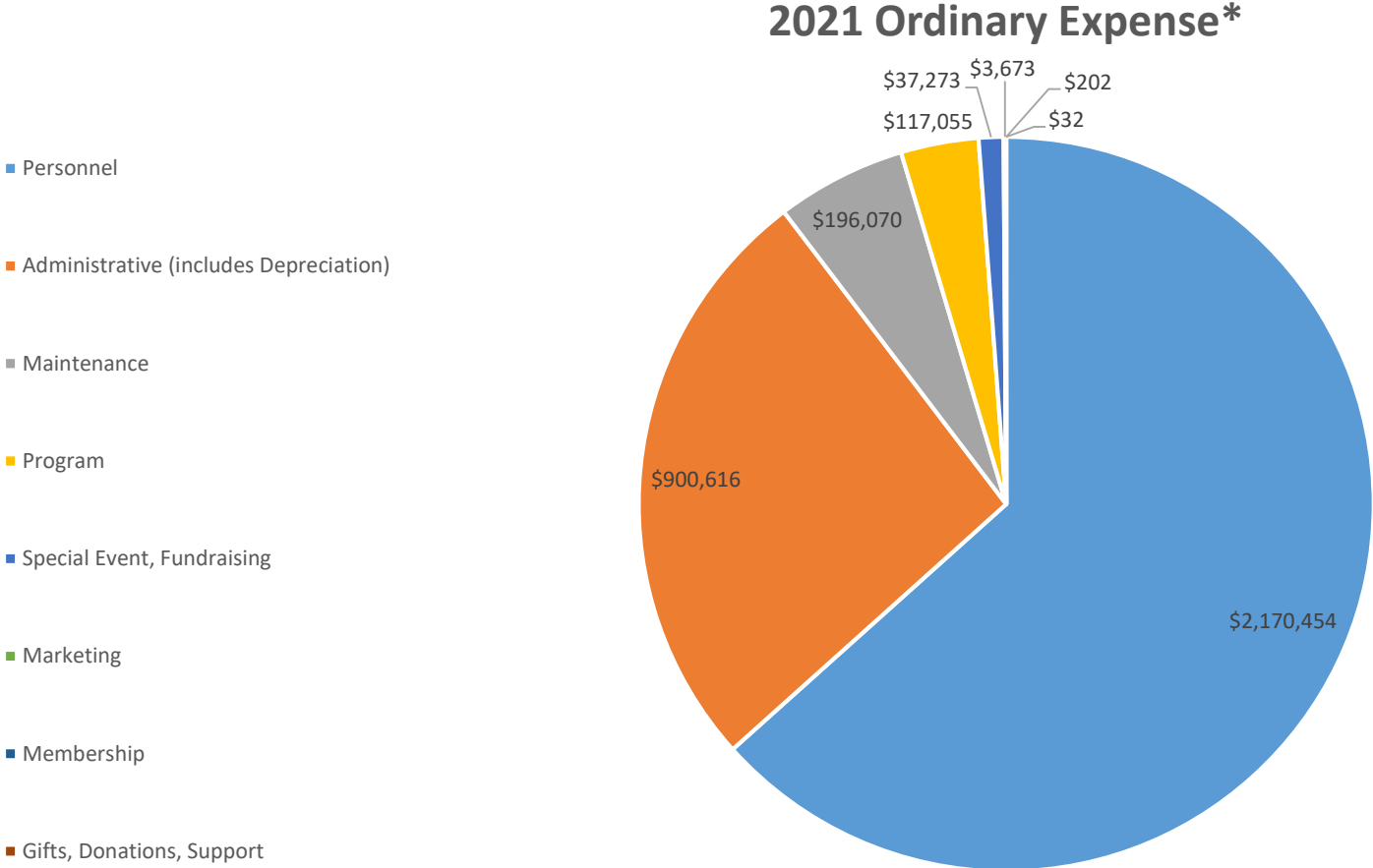
# 2021 Ordinary Income

# 2021 Ordinary Expense

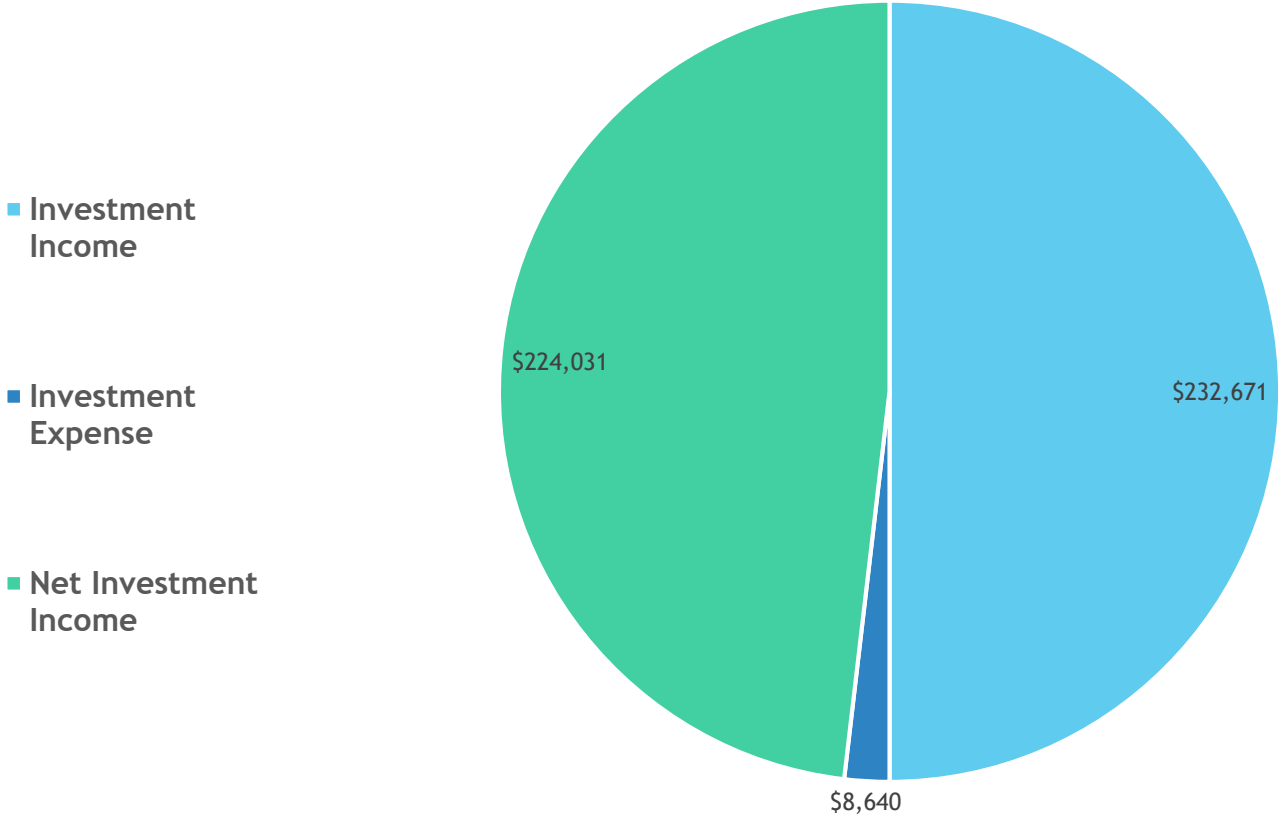


**\*Total Ordinary Expense of \$3,425,376.**

# Program Highlights

## Youth and Camp Programming

- ▶ 2021 Camp Shalom and Teen Camp had a successful 10 week run, with over 800 camper weeks. Registrations for summer 2022 came in early and quick.
- ▶ Started a Teen Leadership program that included resume building skills and volunteer opportunities. 9th and 10th grade Teen Campers will serve as CIT for this summer's Camp Shalom.
- ▶ Afterschool numbers at ASH, Montessori, and JCC increased as the school year progressed. From June 2021 to June 2022 enrollment increased by 56 children.

## Jewish Culture and Senior Programming

- ▶ Senior congregant meals resumed in January 2022. Serving between 10-30 meals per week.
- ▶ The Massry Center for Adults has activities and classes every day of the week! Volunteers lead Mahjong, knitting, bridge, and more. We also have talented instructors teaching art, directing the adult chorale, Hebrew classes, and more.
- ▶ Our partnership with Temple Israel and SJCC to offer PJ Library to families with young children continues. Families picked up adventure kits from the JCC and Zoomed into the monthly sessions.
- ▶ In June our Live & Learn Lunch program returned. Adults learned how to upcycle a book into art with a book folding lesson from local author, Beth Dounane.



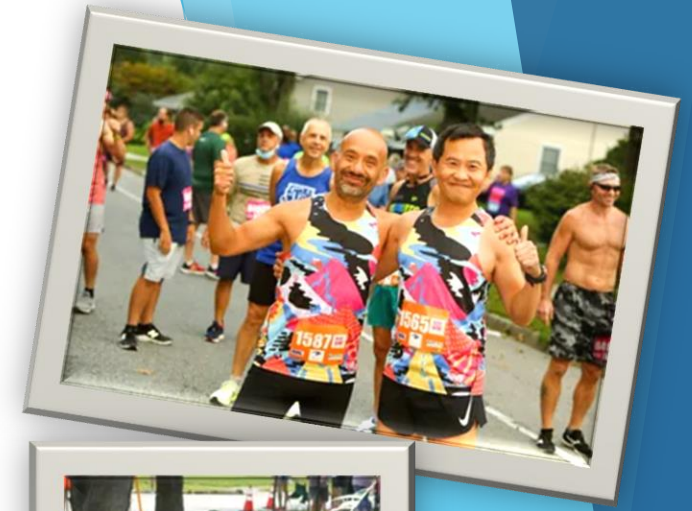

## Fitness Programming and Membership

- ▶ Replaced the Indoor Cycling bikes and created a dedicated Personal Training room.
- ▶ Hired two need personal trainers and are investing in fitness staff through the use of Club Connect, a continuing education tool.
- ▶ CYO Basketball returned and the JCC team won the championship.
- ▶ Restarted the volleyball league and launched a very successful adult Pickleball league.
- ▶ Access to join the AJCC is now available online

## Aquatics Programming

- ▶ Aqua Aerobics classes happen 5 days per week and have a loyal following.
- ▶ Swim lessons have been sold out since returning in the fall of 2021.
- ▶ Camp Shalom campers received daily swim lessons thanks to the cooperation between aquatics staff and camp counselors.
- ▶ The ARROWS swim team has been going non-stop since returning in 2020 and have been busy attending several regional meets.

## Early Childhood Programming

- ▶ In March 2022, parents came back into the building for the first time in two years.
- ▶ Opened two toddler classrooms bringing enrollment to 147 children.
- ▶ Partnered with the fitness dept to offer Zumba classes to the 4y olds
- ▶ Had a STREAM (science, technology, reading, engineering, art, and math) teacher for the year and recently hired a music teacher.
- ▶ PTO group held several successful events, and showed their support of teachers with specials lunches, treats, and appreciation weeks.
- ▶ Held our first in-person model seder since 2019.



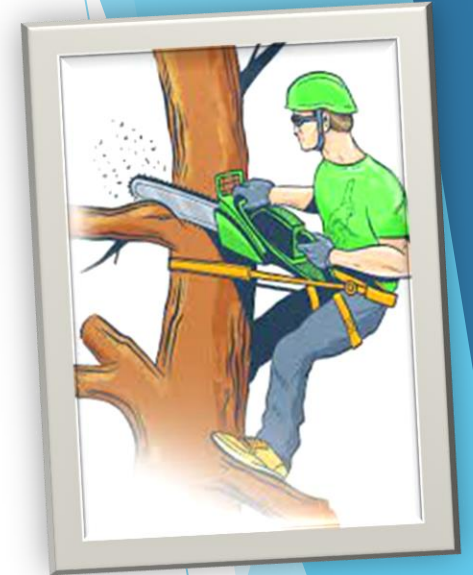

## Facility Improvements

- ▶ Thanks to a NYS Security Grant we added additional lighting to the exterior of the building and installed video cameras that cover the entire perimeter of the building.
- ▶ The parking lot pot holes were patched and the upper parking lot pole lights were changed to LED.
- ▶ Trees in the ECC playgrounds were removed to allow for more light, better drainage, and for the longevity of the building.
- ▶ Inner courtyard playground was re-graded to address flooding issues and all playgrounds received fresh mulch to enhance child safety.
- ▶ Currently all lights throughout the building are being changed to LED.
