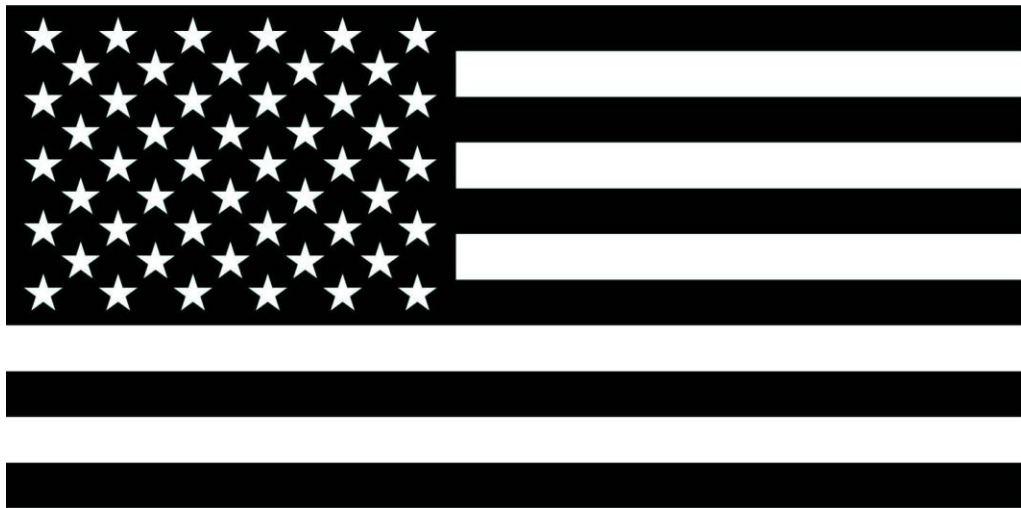
His poetry and fiction have appeared in Harper's, The Yale Review, The Southern Review, Prairie Schooner and other publications.
